

THE LAST 42 MONTHS OF THE GREAT TRIBULATION

----- God's Full Wrath -----

-The Seven Bowls of Wrath

God Himself commands the 7 angels to pour out His wrath on Earth:

John hears the voice of God coming from His temple: Rev 16:1 I heard a great voice out of the temple saying to the seven angels, Go and pour out the vials of the anger of God on the earth. The full wrath of the “**anger of God**” is coming! Since the Great Multitude, the two witnesses, and the 144,000 Jews are in Heaven, God will now pour out His entire wrath upon the inhabitants of the Earth. This will all happen in the second half of the 7-year great tribulation. God had given countless warnings to men about the consequences of rejecting Him; He was honest with them; He had said that one day He would pour His wrath upon the Earth. He had let everyone know about the consequences faced by those who had disobeyed Him in the past; He told us He had once made the whole Earth flood because of the sinfulness of men; He told us about Sodom and Gomorrah and how He did not spare its inhabitants when they committed great sins. But many people had ignored God's warnings, so He is now about to do what He had said He would do all along. He is going to pour His full wrath upon those who would follow the antichrist and receive his mark.

THE 7 BOWLS OF THE ANGER OF GOD:

GOD HIMSELF COMMANDS THE 7 ANGELS TO START -
POURING OUT HIS WRATH UPON THE EARTH.

THIS HAPPENS IN THE SECOND HALF OF THE TRIBULATION

Rev 15:1 And I saw another sign in Heaven, great and marvelous: seven angels with the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God. IN THEM IS FILLED UP THE WRATH OF GOD

-The First Bowl

Rev. 16:2 And the first went and poured out his bowl on the earth. And a bad and grievous sore fell on the men who had the mark of the beast, and on those who worshiped his image. How unfortunate for those who made the decision to accept the mark of the beast after being warned not to. The beast had (falsely) offered them health, peace, love, prosperity, and everything they could have ever wanted, but what they will really get is the exact opposite. The first thing they will receive is bad and grievous sores.

-The Second Bowl

Rev. 16:3 And the second angel poured out his vial on the sea. And it became like the **blood of a dead one**, and every living soul **died in the sea**. This judgment is literal, just as God did it back in Egypt when Moses turned the water into blood. But we know that God turned the blood back into water. And He will do so again at this time because we will return to live here for 1,000 years with Christ. Notice that every living soul in the sea will die. How unfortunate that the sins of men will bring death to innocent creatures. But our God is the Creator of life, so you can be assured that He will bring life back to the sea. He is the God of life and not of death.

Some might ask, how do you know that it is literal? Well, just look at the results; ***“every living soul died in the sea.”*** If every living soul dies, it is because the waters literally became like the blood of a dead man. The blood of a dead man is thick, dry, and it stinks.

-The Third Bowl

Rev. 16:4 And the third angel poured out his vial on the rivers and **fountains of waters**, and they became **blood**. The water in the sea had been turned to blood, and now the rivers and all the fresh waters will follow so that literally all the waters on Earth will turn into blood. I remind you that God will turn all the waters back into clean, healed waters, look at Ezekiel: Ezk 47:8-10 The waters will be healed.

-The Angel of the Waters

Rev 16:5-7 And I heard the **angel of the waters** say, **Righteous is the Lord, who is, and was, and who will be**, because You have judged these things, since they have poured out the blood of the saints and prophets; and You gave them blood to drink, for they were deserving. And I heard **another** out of the altar saying (this “another” is the souls under the altar that wanted justice), Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous are Your judgments. God’s angel, who protects the waters says that God is righteous in His judgment when the second and third bowls are poured out, causing the waters to turn into blood. Another voice out of the altar echoes this response, saying God is a righteous judge. So we see that our God is not an evil judge because these two witnesses confirm that His judgment is righteous. And Jesus told us: Jn 8:17 It is also written in your Law that the testimony of two men is true. This proves that God’s judgments are true and righteous, since there are two giving testimony. The fact that the angel who protects the waters, speaks out proves that the waters were literally turned into blood.

-The Fourth Bowl

Rev 16:8-9 And the fourth angel poured out his vial onto the sun. And it was given to him to **burn men with fire**. And men were burned with the **great heat**. And they blasphemed the name of God, he having authority over these plagues. And they did not repent in order to give Him glory. Some scientists are predicting that the ozone layer will eventually have a huge hole, allowing the sun's rays to burn the inhabitants of the Earth. And this fourth bowl judgment will make the sun get hotter. Notice this prophecy in, Is 30:26: And the light of the moon shall be as the light of the sun, and the light of the sun shall be **sevenfold**, as the light of seven days. An increase in the sun's temperature by seven is incredibly hot! The sun will become so bright that even the reflection from the moon will be as the light of the sun. This is also a literal judgment since we read that; "**men were burned with the great heat.**" If you can't bear the summer heat now, imagine the heat at that time.

-The Fifth Bowl

Rev 16:10-11 And the fifth angel poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and its kingdom became **darkened**. And they gnawed their tongues from the pain. And they blasphemed the God of Heaven because of their pains and their sores. And they did not repent of their **deeds**. Those who received the mark of the beast will receive this plague, and they will feel so much pain that they will bite their tongues in agony. Yet they will continue to blaspheme God and will not repent of their sins. Why? Because these sinful people want to blame God for everything that happens to them, even though God had warned them of what would come. Yet they seem to have no complaints against the antichrist, which they look up to, even though he will do nothing for them but make false promises, and cause them to be sent to the Lake of Fire for all eternity.

-Where is the Logic?

I am not the most intelligent person in the world, but I do have some common sense. And I continue to wonder: why do some people hate God? If He shows us all the warning signs and we choose to ignore them, we will suffer the consequences of doing that which He warned us not to do. If a friend warns you not to go to a certain place because there is a lot of crime there, and you go anyway and are victimized, will you come back and blame your friend for your misfortunes? Let's use good logic and believe in God and in His Son.

-The Sixth Bowl

Rev 16:12 And the sixth angel poured out his vial on the great river Euphrates. And its water was dried up, so that the way of the kings from the rising of the sun **might be prepared**. The river will be dried to allow the antichrist to gather all his militaries in Israel so that they will be able to fight against Jesus Christ and His saints. The devil knew the promise that God gave to His people – the promise that Jesus Christ would rule from Israel Mic 5:2. The battle of Armageddon will be in Israel, and Satan will fight with the armies of the antichrist against Jesus for that land. The Lamb will overcome them Rev 17:14.

THE SIXTH BOWL:

THE GREAT RIVER EUPHRATES WAS DRIED UP-
SO THAT THE WAY OF THE KINGS MIGHT BE PREPARED
THE ANTICHRIST GATHERS HIS MILITARIES IN ISRAEL
THE DEVIL KNOWS THAT JESUS WILL REIGN FROM ISRAEL
HE WILL TRY TO STOP JESUS FROM COMING TO ISRAEL

AN INTERESTING FACT:

The Devil knows that Jesus will come to reign on Earth, and that His Kingdom will be in Israel, that is why he will bring the antichrist's armies there in his attempt to prevent Christ from reigning in Israel. Satan knows this will happen because it is written in the Bible. Yet the false teachers of today, who should believe everything that God tells us amazingly deny that Jesus will rule on this Earth for 1,000 years.

This is very embarrassing, the devil knows God's word is true, yet these false teachers deny God's word, which tells us that Jesus will be King on Earth for 1,000 years. They deny this:

Rev 20:1 And I saw an angel come down from Heaven, having the key of the abyss and a great chain in his hand. Rev 20:2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, who is the Devil and Satan, and bound him a **thousand years**. Rev 20:3 And he cast him into the abyss and shut him up and set a seal on him, that he should deceive the nations no more until the **thousand years** should be fulfilled. And after that he must be loosed a little time. Rev 20:4 And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for the witness of Jesus and for the Word of God, and who had not worshiped the beast nor his image, nor had received his mark on their foreheads, nor in their hands. And they lived and reigned with Christ a **thousand years**. Rev 20:5 But the rest of the dead did not live again until the **thousand years** were finished.

This is the first resurrection. Rev 20:6 *Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection. The second death has no authority over these, but they will be priests of God and of Christ, and will reign with Him a thousand years.* Rev 20:7 *And when the thousand years have expired, Satan will be loosed out of his prison.* **How stubborn** do you have to be in order to **ignore** all of these verses that clearly state that Jesus will be King on this Earth for 1,000 years?

These false teachers say that men's popular opinions have been that there will not be a thousand-year-reign of Christ, therefore we are to ignore the scriptures, yet I am one that could care less of men's opinions, for I base my opinions **on scripture**. If we used the same logic of believing and following men's popular opinions, we would have been called "**fools**" by Jesus Christ, since the popular opinion of men was that the Christ was not to be killed Luke 24:25. Yet Jesus fulfilled that prophecy anyway, just as He will fulfill His prophecy of reigning on this Earth for 1,000 years. If these false teachers truly believed the popular opinion, they would believe that the book of Revelation was written around **95 AD** and not before 70 AD.

SINCE DANIEL'S TIME, GOD HAS GIVEN US A TIMELINE:

- (1) From Daniel's time to Christ's crucifixion Dn 9:25-26
- (2) From Christ's resurrection to 2,000 years later when 144,000 Jews will believe in Jesus Hosea 6:2 and the Rapture happens Rev 7:1-17
- (3) After the Rapture, the 7 years of tribulation begins Dn 9:27
- (4) The first 1,260 days Rev 11:3, Rev 12:6, Rev 12:14
- (5) The 30 day gap Dn 12:11 and the last 42 months Dn 7:25, 12:7, Rev 11:2, 13:5
- (6) The 1,000 year reign of Christ Dn 7:14, Hosea 6:2, Rev 20:4, 20:6
- (7) Eternity Rev 21:3-5

Daniel told us that Messiah would be cut off Dn 9:25-26

Hosea told us that Israel would be revived to live in the presence of Christ on the 3rd day Hosea 6:2 (3rd Millennium)

Daniel & **Revelation** told us of the 7 year tribulation

Hosea & **Revelation** told us of the 1,000 year reign of Christ

Revelation told us of Eternity

Jesus showed us 6,000 years + 1,000 years in Mt 17:1-2 & Mar 9:2-3

(4,000 years) ✠ (2,000 years) + (7 years) + (1,000 years) + (Eternity)

The 7 days or 7,000 years:

In the first day Adam died at 930 years Gen 2:17, 5:5

On the Seventh and last day Christ reigns Rev 20:2-7

Christ promised that on the last day: Jn 6:39-40, 44, 54, 11:24, 12:48

CHRIST IS RETURNING, SO THE NATIONS WILL PREPARE:

Rev 11:18 *The nations were angry, and Your wrath has come*

Psa 2:1 *Why do the nations rage, and the peoples meditate on a vain thing?* Psa 2:2 *The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers plot together, against Jehovah and against His anointed, saying,*

Let us break their bands in two and cast away their cords from us. Psa 2:4

He who sits in the heavens shall laugh; Jehovah shall mock at them. Psa

2:5 *Then He shall speak to them in His anger, and trouble them in His wrath* Rev 14:19. Psa 2:6 *Yea, I have set My king on My holy hill, on Zion.*

Psa 2:7 *will declare the decree of Jehovah. He has said to Me, You are My Son; today I have begotten You.* Psa 2:8 *Ask of Me, and I shall give the*

nations for Your inheritance; and the uttermost parts of the earth for Your possession. Psa 2:9 *You shall break them with a rod of iron; You*

shall dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel. Psa 2:10 **And now (in the Millennium)** *be wise, O kings; be instructed, O judges of the earth.*

Psa 2:11 *Serve Jehovah with fear, and rejoice with trembling.* Psa 2:12 *Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, and you perish from the way, when His wrath is*

*kindled in but a little time. **Blessed** are all who put their trust in Him.*

The beast and his 10 kings plot against Jehovah & Jesus “His anointed”

He who sits in the heavens shall laugh; Jehovah shall mock at them

He shall speak to them in His anger, and send them His wrath Rev 19:15

You are My Son; today I have begotten You Heb 1:5

I give the nations as Your inheritance & the earth for Your possession
