

-And I Saw Thrones (The Souls Came to Life)

The saints will now receive their positions on the Millennial Kingdom of Christ: Rev 20:4 *And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for the witness of Jesus and for the Word of God, and who had not worshiped the beast nor his image, nor had received his mark on their foreheads, nor in their hands. And they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.* (Also seen in Dn 7:9, 22.)

John saw the thrones that Jesus placed on Earth for those who had believed in Him, and he also saw the souls of those who were killed by the antichrist during the Great Tribulation, and they lived, that is to say that they were transformed and received an incorruptible and immortal body, just as those who were raptured; they, too, will reign with Jesus Christ in the Millennial Kingdom.

I recall the promise of Jesus Christ that we would be **kings** and **priests** with Him Rev 5:10, and that we would rule with a rod of iron: Rev 2:26-27. The reason that Jesus along with His saints will rule with a **rod of iron** Rev 12:5 is that there will be firm rules in the Millennial reign of Christ, so that no one will rise up and say they have the right to kill their babies (abortion) or teach heresies to others.

When Christ rules along with us, with rods of iron, the people who remain on Earth will either agree with Jesus Christ, or they will reject Him; but either way, they will have to obey Him. I want to make it clear that Jesus will not rule over the saints with a rod of iron, He will only reign with a rod of iron over the mortals. The strict rules will keep the mortals in line.

The 12 apostles of Christ will sit on 12 thrones in Israel. Jesus said this in: Mt 19:28 *And Jesus said to them, Truly I say to you that you who have followed Me, in the regeneration, when the Son of Man shall sit in the throne of His glory, you also shall sit on twelve throne, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.* **And**, Luke 22:28 *You are those who have continued with Me in My trials.* Luke 22:29 *And I appoint a kingdom to you, as My Father has appointed to Me,* Luke 22:30 *that you may eat and drink at My table in My kingdom, and sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel.* The 12 apostles of Jesus will be sitting on 12 thrones in Israel “*judging the twelve tribes*” during the Millennial Reign of Christ. A remnant of the twelve tribes shall return Is 10:22.

The rest of the saints will have their thrones placed throughout the Earth, so that every family will be able to come to the saints and ask for justice, we will rule and reign with Christ in a just way Ezk 44:24. The mortals won't have to travel to Israel to get justice every time there is a dispute since we will have our thrones placed near them.

-The First Resurrection

We read of the first resurrection: Rev 20:5-6 *But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished.* (The rest of the dead are those who stayed in hell since they did not believe in Christ.) *This is the first resurrection. Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection. The second death has no authority over these, but they will be priests of God and of Christ, and will reign with Him a thousand years.* If there is a first resurrection, there must be a second one, and it will happen after the Millennial Kingdom. Notice that John writes: ***“blessed and holy is the one who has part in the first resurrection.”*** The reason that we are holy is because Jesus Christ has washed away our sins, and the second death has no power over us. We will have received a new body that is immortal and without sin. And since we have no sin, we cannot be judged; and since our new bodies cannot die, we cannot participate in a second death.

The second resurrection is for those who had rejected God. They will be waiting in a holding place called hell until they are resurrected with all the men who will be killed at the end of the millennial reign of Christ. They will receive their flesh, soul, and spirit, but they will not be transformed, as we will, because they did not believe in Jesus Christ who washes away our sins. Their sins will remain, and as they stand resurrected and sinful in the presence of God, the Book of Life will be opened to see if their names are written in it. And since they did not believe in Jesus Christ, they will be thrown into the Lake of Fire. That is the second resurrection, and it is the reason that those who participated in the first resurrection are considered to be blessed since we will have no part in the second death. The **first death** is when our flesh dies the **second death** is eternal separation from Jesus Christ who is The Life John 11:25.

THE FIRST RESURRECTION:

-The People Left on Earth

The few people who survived the Great Tribulation without having accepted the mark of the beast will have a chance to serve Jesus Christ and His saints without being tempted by the devil. They will be in the presence of Jesus Christ and will see Him face to face as the King of kings and Lord of lords. Hab 2:14 For the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of Jehovah, as the waters cover the sea. Anyone living on Earth will know about Jesus Christ because He will be ruling with a rod of iron, yet He will also reign in the loving way that He always does since He is the God of Love.

The few mortals who will remain will be those who survived through the fire: Zec 13:8 And it shall be in all the land, says Jehovah, two parts in it shall be cut off and die; but the third shall be left in it. Zec 13:9 And I will bring the third part through the fire, and will refine them as silver is refined, and will try them as gold is tried. They shall call on My name, and I will answer them; I will say, It is **My people**; and they shall say, Jehovah is my God. They will now live in the presence of Jesus Christ and His saints. And they will be able to have children, who will multiply in a span of 1,000 years. After the 1,000 years are over, Satan will deceive many of them: Rev 20:8 And he will go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, ... number of them is as the sand of the sea. These people will have to have faith in someone they have seen, for they will see Jesus Christ. But they will still need to have faith in Him as their Savior.

Because of Christ's presence on Earth, it will become a safe place to live. The mortals will start to quickly populate Earth by living long lives Is 65:20 and having many children. The saints will be ruling with Christ. They will be the representatives of Jesus Christ, making rulings, regarding any wrongdoings Ezk 44:24 And in a dispute they shall stand in judgment; and they shall judge it according to My judgments.

We will have the ability to fly since we came back to Earth on the clouds and Isaiah spoke of Jesus reigning on Earth with us and that we should fly: Is 11:10 And in that day there shall be the **Root of Jesse** standing for a banner of the people; to Him the nations shall seek; and His resting place shall be glorious. Is 11:14 But they shall fly on the shoulders of the Philistines... this is a hidden clue that shows us that we will be able to **fly** when Jesus "**the Root of Jesse**" will reign on Earth.

Peter walked on water with the faith that he had, we will also be able to walk on water, since we will have a lot of faith in our immortal bodies.

No more prophets:

In the Millennial Kingdom of Christ the mortals will not be allowed to be prophets. Zec 13:2 *And it shall be in that day, says Jehovah of Hosts, I will cut off the names of the idols out of the land, and they shall be remembered no more. And also I will cause **the prophets** and the unclean spirit to **pass out** of the land.* Zec 13:3 *And it shall be when any shall yet prophesy, his father and his mother who gave birth to him shall say to him then, You shall **not live**; for you speak **lies** in the name of Jehovah. And his father and his mother who gave him birth shall thrust him through when he prophesies.* Zec 13:4 *And it shall be in that day, the prophets shall be ashamed, each one of his **vision**, when he **prophesies**.* Dn 9:24 *seal up the vision and prophecy*

-Christ will Heal the Sick in the Millennium

Jesus will heal the sick (that have faith) in the Millennium just as He did the first time he came to Earth, Jesus said: Luke 4:18 *The Spirit of the Lord is on Me; because of this He has **anointed** Me to proclaim the Gospel to the poor. He has sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim deliverance to the captives, and new sight to the blind, to set at liberty those having been crushed.* Christ told us that the Holy Spirit was upon Him, because He had received Him when He was baptized, and He was anointed as Daniel said: Dn 9:24 *to anoint the Most Holy.*

When John the Baptist wanted to know if Jesus was the Christ, Jesus responded: Luke 7:22 *And answering, Jesus said to them, Go and tell John what you have seen and heard; that the **blind see**, the lame walk, the lepers are **cleansed**, the deaf **hear**, the dead are **raised**, and the gospel is proclaimed to the poor.* Jesus wanted John to realize that He was the Christ, and He confirms it by saying that He was fulfilling the prophecies of the messiah since He was healing the sick.

Isaiah said: Is 35:5 *Then the eyes of the **blind** shall be opened, and the ears of the **deaf** shall be unstopped.* Is 35:6 *Then the **lame** shall leap like a deer, and the tongue of the **dumb** shall sing; for in the wilderness waters shall break out, and streams in the desert.* Is 42:6 *I Jehovah have called You in righteousness, and will hold Your hand, and will keep You, and give You for a covenant of the people, for a Light of the nations;* Is 42:7 *to open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, those who sit in darkness out of the prison house.* Jesus fulfilled these prophecies the first time He came, and He will fulfill them again in the Millennium. Therefore, this prophecy will happen twice. There will also be trees with: Ezk 47:12 *leaves for healing*

-Sacrifices Return

The saints will be kings and priests: Rev 5:10: And You made us **kings and priests** to our God, and we will reign over the earth. Why would we be priests? Because there will be sacrifices in the 1,000-year reign of Christ. Now, the saints will not sacrifice any animals for their sins, since we won't have any sins, but there will be mortals who will present their animals to be sacrificed by the immortal priests as we see:

Zec 14:16 And it shall be, everyone who is **left** of all the nations which came up against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to **worship the King, Jehovah of Hosts, and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.** Zec 14:21: Yea, every pot in Jerusalem and in Judah shall be holy to Jehovah of Hosts. And all those who **sacrifice** shall come and take of them, and boil in them. And in that day there shall no longer be a trader in the house of Jehovah of Hosts. These people “**who are left of all the nations which came up against Jerusalem**” are the ones who survived the great tribulation and were not killed by the antichrist. Notice that they were “*of the nations*” that came up against Jerusalem in the battle of Armageddon, but they did not come to the battle, so they lived in those nations, but they did not participate in the battle against Jesus. Therefore, they will have a second chance.

Why will sacrifices of animals be necessary in the millennial reign of Christ? They will serve to remind them about the ultimate sacrifice that Jesus provided for us. Animal sacrifices made us feel guilty that an innocent animal would be killed because of our sins.

When we were under the law, people had to spend money to pay for their sacrifices. But when Jesus paid the ultimate price, we fell under His grace Jn 1:17 so that when we sin today, we ask for forgiveness, and He freely grants it. You do not have to spend money on a sacrifice as people previously did. They did sacrifices to be obedient to God.

Jn 1:17 For the **Law** came through Moses, but **grace** and truth came through Jesus Christ.

The mortals left on Earth during the reign of Christ will have the advantage of seeing Him, but they will no longer be under His grace. When they sin, they will be required to buy and kill an innocent animal as a sacrifice because of their sins. (**It will cost them**) This will point them **back to the cross**, so that they may appreciate the price that **Jesus** paid for the sins of the world. Although these animal sacrifices will be required, they in no way will wash away people's sins; no animal sacrifice ever has, or ever will. Heb 10:4 For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.

Make no mistake about it, in the millennial reign of Christ, people will be able to believe in Jesus Christ and receive Him as their Savior. But as they have children, their children will ask why they need to kill innocent animals. Their parents will point them back to the sacrifice of an innocent man that was necessary to wash away sins. Please understand that at this time, children will grow up with never having experienced the great tribulation or these years in which we have computers and televisions.

Today, we have faith in Jesus in **two ways**: one is to believe in Him who we have not yet seen Heb 11:1, and the other is to believe in Him as our Savior Gal 2:16. The mortals during the millennial reign will have Him in their presence (**they will see Him**), and they will know He is The Savior, but they will make sacrifices to remind them and their children of the price Jesus paid for them on the cross.

So why did people sacrifice animals when they were under the law? Let me reiterate to make this clear: it was not to wash away our sins. It was to make them feel guilty for their sins because it was their sin that would cause an innocent animal to be killed. The sacrifice was also to show them that an innocent man would have to die for their sins. They had to look forward towards the Redeemer who would redeem our sinful bodies by transforming them into sinless immortal bodies 1 cor 15:53. Job said: Job 19:25-26 *For I know that my Redeemer lives, and He shall rise on the earth at the last; and even after they corrupt my skin, yet this: in my flesh I shall see God.* How did Job know he needed a Redeemer? Our God revealed it to him, and they looked forward to Christ by faith. Job said: *in my flesh I shall see God.*

Our flesh will not be destroyed, it will be redeemed!

Isa 44:6 *So says Jehovah, the King of Israel, and His redeemer Jehovah of Hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and besides Me there is no God.* Jesus is our Redeemer, The First and the Last Rev 2:8.

What can wash away our sins? Nothing but the blood of Jesus!

THE SACRIFICES IN THE OLD TESTAMENT LAW: POINTED FORWARD TO THE CROSS

THE SACRIFICES IN THE MILLENNIAL REIGN: WILL POINT BACK TO THE CROSS

-We Are Told That the Law Will Return in the Millennium

Let's look at what the prophet Micah said: Mic 4:1 *But it shall be in the last days the mountain of the house of Jehovah shall be established in the top of the mountains, and it shall be lifted up above the hills; and peoples shall flow to it.* Mic 4:2 *And many nations shall come and say, Come and let us go up to the mountain of Jehovah, and to the house of the God of Jacob. And He will teach us of His ways, and we will walk in His paths; for the Law shall go forth out of Zion, and the Word of Jehovah from Jerusalem.* Micah is clearly speaking of the Millennial reign of Christ when he says that: ***“in the last days the mountain of the house of Jehovah shall be established in the top of the mountains.”*** The mountain of the house of Jehovah is where Jesus will reign for 1,000 years, and the people of the nations will say, *“let us go up to the mountain of Jehovah”* and, *“He will teach us of His ways, and we will walk in His paths; for the Law shall go forth out of Zion, and the Word of Jehovah from Jerusalem.”* The mortals will say that Christ will teach them His ways and that the Law will come out of Zion which is in Israel.

In Isaiah, this same prophecy is repeated: Is 2:2 *And it shall be, in the last days the mountain of Jehovah's house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow into it.* Is 2:3 *And many people shall go and say, Come, and let us go to the mountain of Jehovah, to the house of the God of Jacob. And He will teach us of His ways, and we will walk in His paths. For out of Zion shall go out the Law, and the Word of Jehovah from Jerusalem.* We are told twice, by both Micah and Isaiah: **FOR OUT OF ZION SHALL GO OUT THE LAW** (Mic 4:2 and Is 2:3)

What good can come out of the law returning? Well, there will be strict rules that the mortals will have to follow, and this will show the Lord if they truly love Him. Those that love the Lord will gladly obey the law, while those who don't truly love Him will complain and eventually disobey Him by rejecting the law. Jn 14:15

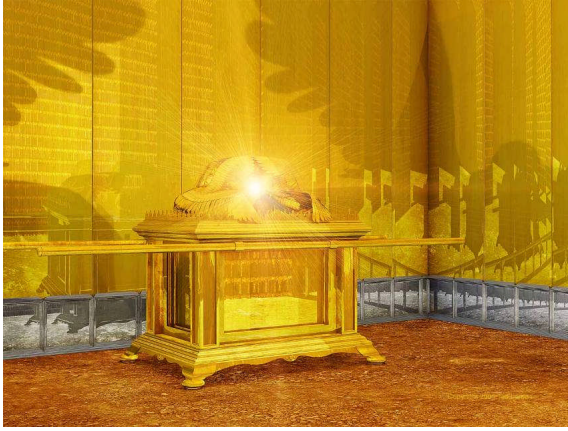
